**Our brother and fellow priest, Father Adolph J. Redwick, entered eternal life on March 6, 2006 at the age of 73.**

**Father Redwick was born on August 28, 1932, in Detroit and ordained a priest for the Archdiocese of Detroit on June 6, 1959. His many assignments included serving as Parochial Vicar at St. Thomas Aquinas and SS. Peter and Paul, both in Detroit; Pastor and Administrator at Christ the Good Shepherd, Lincoln Park; Vicar, Old Southland Vicariate and, most recently, as Pastor, St. Joseph, Dearborn.**

**Sajewski Funeral Home is handling the arrangements, 19111 W. Warren, Detroit (313-271-2500). Visitation will be on Wednesday, March 8, from 1 to 9 p.m. Father's body will be transferred to St. Joseph Church, 16101 Rotunda, Dearborn, on Thursday, March 9. Father Redwick will lie in state at the parish and visitation will take place from noon until 9 p.m. Visitation will continue at the parish on Friday, March 10, beginning at 10 a.m. until the celebration of his funeral Mass at 11 a.m. Burial will take place at Mt. Olivet Cemetery, 17100 Van Dyke (at McNichols), Detroit.**
