CTND Wins Award

WASHINGTON - The Catholic Television Network of Detroit (CTND), the Detroit-based archdiocesan cable channel, was honored with a 2005 Proclaim Award from the Catholic Communications Campaign for "Dialogue: Ad Limina," a special edition of the program recorded in May 2004 in Rome.

The award for CTND was one of six Proclaim Awards presented Sept. 25 at the Pope John Paul II Cultural Center in Washington, D.C.

The regular CTND series "Dialogue" is typically taped in the cable channel's studios in the Gabriel Richard Building in downtown Detroit.

The program was written and hosted by Ned McGrath, communications director for the Archdiocese of Detroit, and Karl Seilo, with McGrath as executive producer and Seilo as producer. It was taped by a Rome-based video crew.
