Dear Father:

Our brother and fellow priest, Father Dominic Rossi, PIME, entered eternal life on March 4, at the age of 92.

Father Rossi was born on October 8, 1915, in Cantalice, Italy, and ordained a priest on September 23, 1938. His missionary assignments took him all over the world including Africa, Ethiopia and Brazil. Father Rossi served as pastor of San Francesco Parish, Detroit/Clinton Township for over 30 years. Father Rossi will be waked at the Bagnasco-Calcaterra & Sons Funeral Home, 13650 East Fifteen Mile Road, Sterling Heights (586-977-7300). Visitation will be on Saturday, March 8, from 1 until 9 p.m. Visitation will resume at San Francesco Parish, 22870 S. Nunneley, Clinton Township on Sunday, March 9 from 3 until 9 p.m. Father Rossi's body will lie in state at San Francesco Parish on Monday, March 10 from 8 a.m. until the celebration of his funeral Mass at 10 a.m. Burial will take place at Resurrection Cemetery, Clinton Township.

Father Rossi is survived by four nephews in Italy, Father Bernardino, PIME (who served as Associate Pastor at San Francesco Parish while Father Rossi was Pastor); Orlando; Fiorenzo; and Francesco. Condolences may be sent to the Very Reverend Kenneth Mazur, PIME, at the address listed below.
