Our brother and fellow priest, Father Pasquale LoGrasso, entered eternal life on Friday, September 5, at the age of 76.

Father LoGrasso was born on August 27, 1932 in Terrasini, Italy, and ordained a priest for the Archdiocese of Detroit on June 1, 1957. He served as associate pastor at St. Rita, Detroit; Patronage of St. Joseph, Detroit; St. Jude, Detroit; and St. Martin of Tours, Detroit; and as pastor at St. David, Detroit; St. Louise de Marillac, Warren; and St. Louis, Clinton Township.

He will be waked at the Wujek Calcaterra & Sons Funeral Home, 36900 Schoenherr Road, Sterling Heights (586) 826-8550. Visitation hours will be on Sunday, September 7, from 3 until 9 p.m. and on Monday, September 8, from 1 until 9 p.m. with a prayer service at 7:30 p.m.

Father LoGrasso will lie in state on Tuesday, September 9, at St. Louis Parish, Clinton Township, from 9 a.m. until the celebration of his funeral Mass at 11 a.m. Burial will take place at Resurrection Cemetery, Clinton Township.
