We, the **Archdiocesan Pastoral Plan Tracking Committee**, comprised of representative membership from the Consultative Bodies of the Archdiocese, and the Coordinating Committee of the Together in Faith process, envision ourselves as a resource responsible to the Archbishop by coming together as one team to oversee implementation of the objectives of the Together In Faith Plan, Total Pastoral Plan for Priests, Total Pastoral Plan for Deacons and the Hispanic Pastoral Plan that comprise the Archdiocesan Pastoral Planning Process. Entrusted with the hard work of many who have made recommendations in all areas of the plan for the good of the local church, we envision carefully working to ensure that all aspects are properly respected and integrated into an harmonious implementation. We see regular meetings, communication, reporting and accountability to appropriate persons and bodies as a significant part of the results of our work and essential to our mission and purpose. We, lastly, envision an evaluation of our work annually, in two years, and a more complete evaluation and culmination of our work after five years.

We, the **Archdiocesan Pastoral Plan Tracking Committee**, working with existing structures, will meet regularly to **Review** the four parts of the Archdiocesan Pastoral Planning Process, examining how they intersect, prioritizing them as appropriate, and making necessary recommendations to the Archbishop; **Coordinate** and monitor the implementation of the approved recommendations; **Resolve** any coordination conflicts and concerns resulting from the review; **Identify** those who have lead responsibilities for implementing the recommendations with the Archbishop's approval; **Provide** assistance to and monitor the progress of those who have the lead responsibilities for strategic programming which include identification of goals, objectives, action plans with time-lines and budget; **Inform** Regional Bishops and give them the opportunity to provide input about any changes or recommendations prior to them being submitted to the Archbishop; **Review** the progress and results reports; provide regular reports to the Archbishop and appropriate Consultative Bodies for feedback on the progress and results of the strategic programming of the plan; The **Archdiocesan Pastoral Plan Tracking Committee** will make regular reports to appropriate persons and consultative bodies and publish results in respective communication channels, and conduct annual, two and five year evaluations of the plan as it develops.
